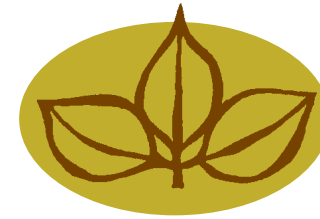

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## Planting Guide

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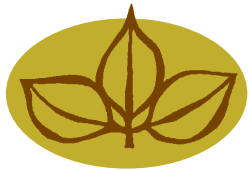

# Planting, feeding and watering for new shrubs and trees...



## Instructions for well-draining soil:

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- 1 DIG** a hole 2 times as wide and the same depth as the pot.
- 2 MIX** our *Organic Flower Bed Amendment* with your native soil according to bag instructions. Add *Osmocote Outdoor Indoor Plant Food* according to product recommendations and mix thoroughly.
- 3 REMOVE** plant from pot and **LOOSEN** its roots.

- 4 PLACE** the plant in the hole so the rootball is a few inches above soil level.
- 5 BACKFILL** with soil mixture, firmly packing soil around rootball.
- 6 WATER:** Make a temporary ring of soil outside of rootball to create a “donut” to hold water. Fill “donut” 3 times allowing water to soak in. New plantings should receive regular waterings. See our Watering Guidelines for specific information.
- 7 MULCH:** Add a 3 inch layer of bark mulch or pinestraw. Keep away from trunk but spread 2 feet around plant to hold in moisture and reduce weeds.



## Instructions for clay or poor-draining soil:

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- 1 DIG** the hole 2 times as wide and half the depth of the rootball. Mix our *Organic Flower Bed Amendment*, *Gypsum*, and *Osmocote Outdoor Indoor Plant Food* with your native soil according to product recommendations.
- 2 REMOVE** plant from pot and loosen its roots. **PLACE** the plant in the hole so the rootball is 1/3 above ground level.

**TIP:** Acid-loving plants like azaleas, camellias, gardenias, and ferns need additional food. We recommend using Espoma Hollytone which is a slow ORGANIC plant food or Miracle-Gro Miracid which is a faster-acting liquid food. Apply as needed.

- 3 BACKFILL** with mixed soil firmly packing around rootball. Additional topsoil will be needed to cover the exposed rootball.
- 4 WATER:** Make a temporary ring of soil outside of rootball to create a “donut” for watering. Fill the “donut” 1-2 times to thoroughly soak plant. Water as necessary—usually 2 times a week, or more frequently during a drought. See our Watering Guidelines for specific recommendations.
- 5 MULCH:** Add a 3 inch layer of bark mulch or pinestraw. Keep away from trunk but spread 2 feet around plant to hold in moisture and reduce weeds.
